Emely Gregory (13 Oct 1859 - 5 May 1903) and William J. Head



Emely Gregory was the first child of the marriage of Nancy Alice Smalling-Wagoner and William Wallace "Varmint" Gregory. Nancy would have been 36 at the time. Emily died at the age of 43 and is buried in the Mount Olive Baptist Church Cemetery in the "Hoghair" community of Ouachita-Jackson Parishes.






